Thank you for your interest for the Erasmus+ Programme and for applying to the 2017 call for proposals for the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE). The Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA) received 331 applications for this call.

A panel of external experts assisted the Evaluation Committee in the evaluation of your application against the award criteria indicated in the call for proposals. The European Commission adopted its Decision for award of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education on 27 October 2016 after taking into consideration: (a) the eligibility decision of the National Authority of your country; (b) the formal eligibility verifications for conformity with the call for proposals eligibility criteria; (c) the evaluation and the recommendations of external experts.

I am pleased to inform you that your application has been selected for the award of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE). You can find the Erasmus code and the PIC attached to your Charter in the subject line of this letter. These two codes must be used in every future Erasmus+ grant application.

By applying for this Charter, your institution has committed itself to implementing the activities funded by the Erasmus+ Programme in line with the fundamental principles of the Charter and to publishing the Erasmus Policy Statement of your institution on the institution's website within one month of receipt of the Charter. The Charter will be sent to you shortly in an electronic format only. As an expression of your commitment to adhere with the Charter, we kindly ask you to

publish the copy of the Charter signed by the legal representative of your institution on the institution's website.

In addition, please note that a new 360° self-assessment "ECHE: make it work for you!" will help you to find out which areas you could strengthen and will provide tailored suggestions to improve your institution's performance. It will be available early next year and you, as a charter holder, will be informed on its release.

For your information, out of the 331 received applications, 218 have been selected for award of an ECHE.
